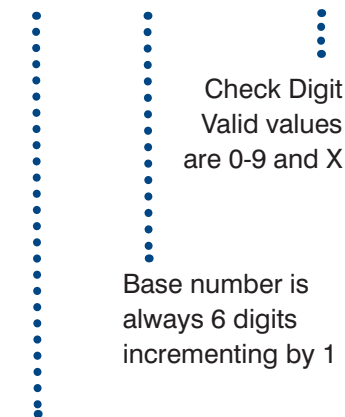




Freight bill numbering

(check digit calculation as of 11/01/08)

999 - 999999 - X



PRO Prefix
- Always 3 digits
- Always constant for
a particular block
of PRO numbers

Check digit calculations

Base number = middle six digits

- Divide base number by 11
- If the remainder is zero the check digit is zero
- Subtract the remainder from 11 to produce the check digit
- Substitute the letter X for the check digit 10

Examples

- Freight bill number: **100-340397-9**
 - 340397 divided by 11 = quotient is 30945, remainder is 2
 - 11 - 2 = check digit is 9
- Freight bill number: **828-561881-X**
 - 561881 divided by 11 = quotient is 51080, remainder is 1
 - 11 - 1 = check digit is 10
 - Must substitute X for 10
- Freight bill number: **111-003542-0**
 - 003542 divided by 11 = quotient is 322, remainder is 0
 - Since the remainder is 0, the check digit is 0
